- Schedule a campus visit** admissions.siu.edu/visit

- Utilize the Saluki Transfer Estimator Portal (STEP)** siu.transfer.degree
Track course equivalency and receive unofficial credit estimation to see how transfer credits apply to your intended program at SIU for a more seamless transfer process.
- Apply to SIU!** admissions.siu.edu/apply
An application fee is due at time of submission. Some students qualify for application fee waivers. To see if you qualify, contact your admission coordinator.
- Compete the FAFSA** fafsa.ed.gov
Each year the FAFSA is available beginning October 1. We recommend completing your FAFSA right away to optimize your financial aid award. Use SIU Federal School Code: 001758.
- Claim your Network ID and setup your password** netid.siu.edu
Your Network ID (SIU + Your Dawg Tag) is used to access campus resources such as SalukiNet, SIU Online (D2L), Computer Lab and Morris Library computers, wireless networking, VPN and more. You will need the Dawg Tag # issued with your SIU admission to claim your Network ID. Your SIU email is your primary source of communication with the university. It will be assigned to you as soon as you register for classes. Sign up to receive textmessages via SalukiNet.
- Complete the SIU Transfer Scholars Program Application** scholarships.siu.edu
The priority deadline for SIU competitive transfer scholarships is February 1 and a completed Transfer Scholars Program Application must be submitted by February 16.

NOW THAT YOU'RE A SALUKI...

- Submit your Housing contract** housing.siu.edu
Transfer students with more than 26 hours have the option to live in traditional residence halls, in on-campus apartments, or off-campus. Use the Housing Portal to submit your contract or apply to live in campus apartments. The Saluki Anytime Dining Plan is included with your housing contract!
- Submit the Immunization Compliance Form** shc.siu.edu/immunizations
Download the Immunization Compliance Form from Student Health Services, complete the contact information, and have a Licensed Health Care Provider complete the remainder OR attach required immunization records. You can obtain immunization records from your physician, local health department, high school, military branch, or previous university.

- Register for Transfer Student Orientation** orientation.siu.edu
We have New Student Orientation (NSO) sessions just for transfer students! While it is not required for transfer students to attend NSO, we highly encourage it. Transfer Student Orientation is a great way to learn about campus, connect with your academic advisor and faculty in your program, and meet your classmates!
- Enroll in classes** advisement.siu.edu/advisors
Students self-register for classes; however, you must first meet with your academic advisor to select your courses and obtain your Registration User Number (RUN).
- Apply for a health insurance refund** shc.siu.edu/health-insurance
Have comparable health insurance? Complete the health insurance fee waiver process by Friday of the second week of class to receive a refund. This credit must be requested annually.
- Establish proxy access** salukinet.siu.edu
Set up a third party (parents/guardians/spouse) as authorized users in SalukiNet and assign them a passphrase. Setting up a proxy allows your designee to communicate with SIU staff on your behalf.
- Set up direct deposit** salukinet.siu.edu
To receive Bursar refunds and student employment wages, direct deposit bank account information is required. Add your bank account information via SalukiNet.
- Complete Financial Aid Requirements** salukinet.siu.edu
Be sure you have accepted or denied financial aid awards, completed entrance loan counseling, and/or submitted verification documents. To access your financial aid award and view important financial aid information log into SalukiNet.
- Obtain a parking decal** parking.siu.edu
Students who commute to campus or plan to bring a car must register their vehicle with the SIU Parking Division and purchase a student parking decal.
- Submit official transcripts** articulation.siu.edu

Make it easy on yourself, request that your college send transcripts electronically through an approved electronic transcript service. Official and final transcripts are required and should be submitted as soon as they are available.
- Sign-up for the installment payment plan** bursar.siu.edu
SIU offers an interest-free monthly payment plan. Enrollment opens July 15 for Fall & December 15 for Spring. Enroll each semester at salukinet.siu.edu.
- View your statement & make payments** bursar.siu.edu
View your bill on the 15th of each month. You can make payments online, by mail, or in person. Your bill is available on SalukiNet.
